The Montgomery County Board of Education supports —

- Preparing all students to be college, career and community ready
- Maintaining the authority of local boards of education to determine educational policy, curriculum, additional graduation requirements, and administration
- Investing in early childhoodincluding universal pre-K, fostering student readiness, and ensuring affordable child care
- Providing equitable
 opportunities and ensuring
 equitable access for all students
- Increased state funding for specialized programs- including Career and Technology Education (CTE) Programs
- Ensuring that any mandated accountability system is implementable and focused on rigor for all, eliminating disparity based on race and economic circumstances

Academic Excellence

- Supporting the physical, social, and psychological well-being for all students
- Creating a safe and secure environment for all students – including innovative strategies to ensure a safe and secure learning and working environment for students and staff
- Providing additional funding to expand training of staff members for students showing signs and symptoms of mental health illness and concerns
- Continued promotion of an atmosphere of respect and nondiscrimination for all students and staff
- Working together with communities and families to include family and community stakeholder voices in policy decisions
- Supporting and partnering with our parent-teacher associations
- Maintain clusters and communities whenever possible during redistricting decisions
- Ensuring support for employee relationships and ensuring fair and equitable treatment of all employees

Well-Being and Family Support

- Fully funding the financial adjustments and any legislatively mandated initiatives, including the Maintenance of Effort formula
- Preserving local autonomy over education- including school calendars, curriculum, testing, and procurement issues
- Supporting student transportation decisions being made at the local level
- A robust and innovative statewide school construction and renovation funding plan
- Establishing incentives for green and energy-efficient school construction.
- Expanding the Maryland Meals for Achievement Program as an entitlement
- Efforts to increase federal funding for the Summer Food Service Program
